REPORT:

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ADMISSION PROCESS SYSTEM

- After announcement of 2nd PUC result, student is supposed to visit the college and enquire about the courses offered, fee structure and college timings.
- The student collects the admission form from the admission committee.
- Interested students fill the applications form and submit the required details as instructed
 by the Bangalore University which will be further verified by the admission committee
 and approved by the Principal.
- Fee is to be deposited in the office.
- At the time of submission of admission form admission number is assigned to the candidate by the institute.
- Candidate gets the receipt of fees deposition.

College has admitted the students by the following criteria which were given by the management and the Bangalore University.

The students seeking permissions for readmission and transfer admission along with no due certificate, no objection certificate, no objection certificate and photocopies of previous semester marks card to the university.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

B.COM

- Candidates must pass two years pre-university examination of Karnataka state or equivalent.
- Candidate who have passed diploma in secretarial/commercial practice conducted by board of technical examination, Karnataka may also eligible for admission directly to the 2nd year of B.Com degree.
- Candidates who have passed diploma in business administration examination conducted by board of technical examination, Karnataka may also eligible for admission directly to the 1st year of B.Com degree.



BBA

 Candidate must pass two years pre-university examination of Karnataka state or equivalent.

BCA

- Candidate must pass two years pre-university or equivalent examination in science, arts or commerce streams with minimum of 35% of marks.
- Candidates who has passed JODC or diploma in engineering with minimum 35% of aggregate marks in all semesters.

B.SC

- Candidate must pass two years pre-university examination of Karnataka state with at least two optional science subjects or other recognized examination.
- Candidates must pass in 10+2 in PCM/PCB

FEE STRUCTURE:

The college has collected the fees from the candidate according to the combination wise.

SCHEME OF EQUAL OPPORTUNITY CENTRE

According to the Guidelines of University Grants Commission & Bangalore University, college has admitted the candidates belong to disadvantaged groups SC, ST, OBC (Non-creamy layer), minorities and physically challenged persons.

ONLINE UPDATION PROCEDURE

The Bangalore University has released online updating procedure for UG students of the year 2021-22. The duration is from 15th November 2021 to 18th November 2021. All the details of first year UG students will be collected and uploaded to the university portal.



Within the given duration the respective class teachers has to collect the following documents from their students. The class teachers need to collect the original documents of 10th/SSLC, 12th/PUC marks card, Transfer certificate, migration, caste, study, income certificate etc.

All the details should be uploaded to the UG portal by the office person and the respective class teachers and download the checklist.

During the verification procedure the following details should be verified by the student such as Candidate name, DOB, Gender, Caste/category, language, marks obtained, percentage, previous board as given in the list.

After verification from the students if any correction is identified by the student should inform to the class teacher then class teacher should give the correct data to the office person which should be entered. Then office person will correct the data by using EDIT option in Bangalore University Portal.

After verification of all the details final upload to the portal to be submitted by November 30, 2021. Then final copy of print out should be taken from the University portal. That will be the final Admission List of UG students of the year 2021-22.
